

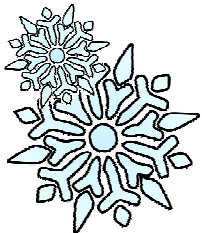

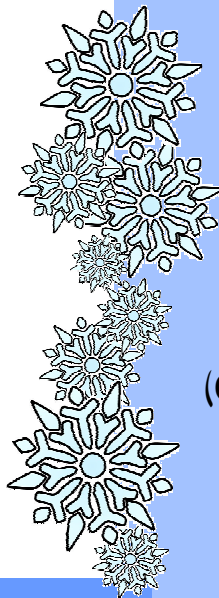

Thanksgiving may not be an official day on the calendar in Honduras, but one young woman and her children are counting their wealth of blessings this holiday season.

Alba has overcome more adversity in her 24 years of life than most people experience in a lifetime. Her father abandoned his family when Alba was in second grade. Hurricane Mitch left them homeless when she was 12. And a freakish shooting incident at age 17 almost killed her.

Yet Alba knows that it is God who has sustained her through it all.

Operation Christmas Child has played an important role in reassuring Alba of God's continual provision and faithfulness. She received a shoe box gift that gave her hope during one of the most heartbreaking times of her life.

It was a great joy this year to see that blessing repeated when her two sons, Juan Carlos, 7, and Bryan, 5, received gifts.

"Never would I have thought that my children would get gifts like I did as a child 12 years ago," Alba said. "I give God the glory that they have a better childhood than I had."
